

Labeler-Art In Action

The job of labeler includes...

+ Make labels. The labels are 14 sets of labels .Each set should have a label with each child's name, St.Charles School, grade ?, 2009-2010 and the artist(write the complete name of the artist) they studied that class, and two sets with no artist's name. You can get this from the program book which should be in the supply box in the first cabinet on the left, in the Upper Hall. Get key 12 from Fran to open the cabinet. You can also look on www.artinaction.org under your grade. The label template is on the St Charles web site. All these labels should be in an envelope in the supply box for your class by the first class. Please do all the labels at the beginning of the year not lesson by lesson as the lesson order sometimes changes.

So you should have one set to use for each of the lessons on the schedule and two extra sets for art shows. Please be sure to spell every child's name and the artist's name correctly. Check the class list and the program book. Please be sure to write the school name in case that piece goes to an art show.

+If there are any problem let your lead docent know and she will see what she can do.
