The job of the classroom hanger includes...

- + Get the AIA schedule for art work to be hung at San Carlos Library.
- + A week before art work is to be hung go to the class box (right closet, upper hall) and find the correct artwork and labels. The ones to be hung should have been chosen by the class lead docent and be ready for you in the box. You might want to call them a few days before to be sure they have them ready. There should be 15 pieces of artwork. Mount them and label them and take them to the library the date listed at 9:00. You hang the art before the library is open.
- + Hang in the St Charles area. There will be a sign there use blue painters tape ONLY to hang artwork. The library is very strict about the blue tape only rule.
- +The day you hang the art work you will also take last months work down. Take this artwork from last month and return it to the correct class box.
- + In June, when the county art show work is chosen, there will be a date for you to help hang the artwork at the library. This takes about 3 hours.
- +If there are any problems let Karen Thrift know and she will see what she can do.
