Grades 1-8

FIRST GRADE

- 2 large pink erasers
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 dozen **sharpened** #2 pencils *(please make sure to get real wood, not composite.)
- 1 dozen TRY-REX brand primary pencil (**sharpened**)
- 1 box **sharpened** colored pencils (12 maximum)
- 1 package marking pens (non-toxic) 12 maximum
- 1 box of crayons (24 maximum)
- 1 small watercolor kit (**8 colors**)
- 4 highlighting pens: pink, yellow, green & blue in Ziplock bag with name (writing program)
- 1 plastic ruler with inches & centimeters (clear or see-through) 12-inch size
- 2 bottles 4oz. each white glue (Elmer's)
- 1 pencil box (approx 8.5" x 5" x 2.5") should be able to hold pencils, markers, etc.
- 1 enclosed pencil sharpener (*manual, no batteries*)
- 1 pair of Fiskars or similar brand children's scissors
- 2 large boxes of tissues (these are collected and put out as needed for all)
- 1 bottle of Purell or similar hand sanitizer (min 8 oz)
- 2 containers of anti-bacterial wipes (Lysol or Purell brands are best)
- 3 new **LARGE plastic disposable tablecloths, solid color (Art-In-Action)**
