

# ST. CHARLES SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST FOR GRADES 1<sup>ST</sup> - 8<sup>TH</sup> 2008-2009

## **FIRST GRADE**

- 2 large pink erasers
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 dozen **sharpened** #2 pencils \*(please make sure to get real wood, not molded.)
- 1 dozen TRY-REX brand primary pencil (**sharpened**)
- 1 package marking pens (non-toxic) 12 maximum
- 1 pair of Fiskars or similar brand children's scissors
- 1 pencil box (approx 8 1/2" x 5" x 2 1/2") should be able to hold pencils, markers, etc.
- 2 large boxes of tissues (these are collected and put out as needed for all)
- 1 small watercolor kit
- 1 bottle of white glue (Elmer's) 4 fl oz.
- 1 box **sharpened** colored pencils (12 maximum)
- 4 Highlighting Pens - pink, yellow, green & blue in Ziplock Pouch with name (for writing program)
- 1 plastic ruler with inches & centimeters (clear or see-through) 12-inch size
- 1 enclosed pencil sharpener (*manual, no batteries*)
- 1 box of crayons (24 maximum)
- 1 Strathmore Kids Series Story Drawing Books - (these can be purchased at the school office in September)
- 2 Jars of Wet Ones
- 1 bottle of Purell or similar hand sanitizer (min 8 oz)
- 2 new **LARGE plastic throw away tablecloths** (*Art-In-Action*)

- New Sponge - NOT scrubber type - *Art-In-Action*
- 1 bottle of **Elmer's** white glue - *Art-In-Action*

- 1 box colored pencils

- 1 old sock (to be used as a whiteboard eraser)
