PAC CHAIRS 2022-2023

PAC Chair - 2 Year Term (Tara Jaramillo-Balestreri)

Oversees parent volunteer activities assigned for all 9 grades; serves as a liaison to all class reps and room parents; recruits volunteers for all PAC positions; communicates about PAC activities with the pastor, principal, faculty liaison and parent community at large; sets the agenda for and leads all PAC Chairs' meetings and quarterly coffees; and presents a status report at monthly School Advisory Board meetings. **Shadow Open for 2023-2024**

PAC Vice Chair/Hospitality - 2 Year Term (Kristina Sullivan)

Supports the Chairperson and serves as a liaison to Hospitality Parents for all 9 grades; trains to take the Chairperson's role following the Chair's term; attends all PAC Chairs' meetings and quarterly Coffees; and tracks and replenishes inventory of PAC supply closet. Attends all PAC Chairs' meetings. **Shadow Open for 2023-2024.**

Secretary - 2 Year Term (OPEN)

Attends all PAC Chairs' meetings and records and distributes minutes; works with the Chairperson and Vice Chair to prepare/update/post PAC forms and documents on the school website.

Ambassador's Committee Chair(s) (Ashely Irvine/Kathleen Casazza/Christine Ross/Gina Igwe/Jill

<u>Cherrstrom</u>): Leads and organizes the Ambassador's Committee to greet prospective and incoming families for all grades, welcoming them into the community in the Fall (welcome baskets, flagpole coffees, mentor calls); supports the administration with marketing outreach, parent tours and kindergarten assessment appointments in Winter; contacts new families and encourages incoming kindergarten families to get together in the Summer. A committee representative attends each PAC meetings.

Parish Community Building Chair - 2 Year Term (OPEN):

Provides spiritual enrichment opportunities for all PAC members, increases communication between parish ministry leaders and our PAC community, encourages Room Parents and Hospitality Chairs to integrate service opportunities into the class celebrations and hospitality events such as Harvest Festival, Santa's Breakfast and more. Attends all PAC meetings and leads with opening prayer.

PAC COMMITTEE COORDINATORS

The following positions attend PAC Chair meetings as needed to give updates and report issues, but monthly meeting attendance is not required.

Art (Tara Jaramillo-Balestreri) Art 4 Schools

Works with administration/teachers to schedule instruction time and reserves Upper Hall. Recruits, schedules and trains volunteers; keeps art materials stocked; organizes artwork showings.

PAC Coffee (Gina Stathacopoulos)

Coordinates refreshments for PAC Coffees and Socials initial PAC Coffee in September and Job Faire Social in May plus additional coffee socials as scheduled. Invites all parents and publicizes the coffee date and agenda in advance.

Book Faire Chairs (Jen Miln/Julie Pforzheimer/Michelle Reed/Kristie Wilhelm)

Plans and coordinates the school's annual Book Faire over four days during Catholic Schools Week in late January, including promotion, volunteer scheduling, set up/clean up, stocking inventory, special book orders and cash management.

Superhero Bowling Coordinator (Sonia Singer)

Plans and coordinates a Mother/Son event during the school year in February.

Sweetheart Dance Coordinator (Tiffany Zabala)

Plan and coordinate the Father/Special Person/Daughter Dance in February.

Wellness Committee (Erika Young/Meredith Larson)

At St. Charles School, we believe there is a positive correlation between children's health and well-being and their ability to learn. Our mission is to promote a faith-filled, healthy, and safe learning environment that values Spiritual, Emotional/Social, Physical, and Intellectual well-being. In January 2016, St. Charles School established a Wellness Committee for the purpose of promoting our students' health and well-being in mind, body, and spirit. The committee is composed of administrators, faculty, and parents. We meet in the evenings approximately seven times per school year.

Grant Writing (OPEN):

Coordinate efforts with the PAC Chair to find, research, write and submit grants to help fund school programs and activities.

Fall Festival Ice Cream Social Coordinator (Amanda Zirelli)

Plan and coordinates the Friday afternoon Ice Cream Social at the parish Fall Festival in September/October. **2023 volunteer position open.**

Christmas Store Coordinator (Tracy Jonson/Natalie Tantillo)

Schedule and coordination of volunteers, donations, supplies, refreshments and set up / clean-up for the Christmas Store for student shoppers in grades K-8.

Walk-a-Thon Coordinator (Becky Cantieri/Victoria Brown)

Assists with the details coordination of the annual Walk-a-Thon, including volunteer coordination, flyers, event day set-up and related tasks.

Tiger Spirit Shop (Becca Kizer)

Coordinate Tiger Spirit Gear shop, merchandise and orders with Goetz.

Uniform Exchange Chair (Victoria Brown, Shadow Megan Ghassemzadeh)

Help organize and sort donated school uniforms. This valued activity helps parents recycle good, clean clothing that their children have outgrown for other students to enjoy. Hosts uniform exchange "shopping day" before school starts.

CLASS REPRESENTATIVES

Each grade has a Class Representative who attends the monthly school board meetings as a representative for their grade. The meetings are generally held on the second Tuesday of the month in the evening. The Class Rep may bring questions/issues to the board from other members of their class. Agenda items should be brought to the board President in time to be put on the agenda. Follow the guidelines given by the board President. The Class Rep also serves as a source of reference for questions parents may have regarding school board issues. The PAC contact person for Class Reps is the PAC Chair. There is a link that Class Reps can contact the School Advisory Board via this form.

ROOM PARENTS

Two, one designated as lead, parents per class split the following duties.

Responsibilities

1. Teacher/Staff Appreciation Account/Gifts

Collect money from your class early in the year for all teachers' gifts throughout the year. The voluntary suggested amount is \$55 per family for gifts of which \$10 per will be used to purchase the main dish for the hospitality monthly teacher lunch. Teachers appreciate gift cards and cash. Generally, Christmas gifts are given to each teacher/staff member who interacts with your class. End of the year gifts are given to the teacher and support staff. Teacher appreciation gifts and birthday gifts are agreed upon by the room parent(s). For reference only. 2. Organize Class Parties

Meet with your teacher early in the year to set class party dates. <u>Teachers</u> will provide dates and approve room parent ideas/themes. It helps to actually pick themes and tentative menus at this time. Each Room Parent can lead the planning for a party. Divide class list and assign parents to bring items so that each family may contribute to at least one party. Encourage all parents to attend/help at the parties. Siblings are not allowed at class parties or field trips. **Please note that classroom funds are not to be used for classroom parties.**

3. Family Assistance

This Room Parent leads in organizing any assistance needed with a family in need or crisis. Also serve as a liaison with the Ambassadors Committee for new families joining at the beginning of the year or mid-year.

4. Lead Room Parent

One Room Parent acts as the point person for the teacher to contact in case he/she needs anything during the year.

HOSPITALITY

Monthly Staff Appreciation Schedule & Hospitality Events

Hospitality Parents are responsible for one monthly teacher luncheon and the hospitality event(s) hosted by your class (a sign up will go out at the beginning of the school year). Prior to your event, you will be provided an email with information about your event. Each class collects \$10 per family to cover the main entree. Hospitality parents coordinate donations for side dishes, beverages and drinks. Grades can coordinate themes.

THE ST. CHARLES SCHOOL ANNUAL SPRING FUNDRAISER

The St. Charles Annual Auction Gala/Spring Fundraising is entering its 37th year! The event is usually held in March or April and is one of the central components of school fundraising efforts. Proceeds from this event support the school's operating budget and have a direct impact on the education, safety and development of our children, and the future of our community. Past years' proceeds have subsidized improvements to the school that are not funded by the annual budget, including enhancements to instructional technologies, safety upgrades, window treatments, and the addition of digital learning tools for our students. This year the format will carry over from last year.

Our continued success with Walk a Thon as well as our recent Back to School BBQ fundraising gives us the opportunity to have an event where our community can come together to celebrate. We will have raffle prizes and our "Giving Tree" which has been received well by our community since its inception. Looking ahead, this format does not need to carry over. Each Auction Chair works with administration to determine event, budget and bottom line. Here is a sample of volunteer positions with a traditional Auction.

ATHLETIC PROGRAM INFORMATION

Sports are a strong tradition at St. Charles School. The program is maintained by a parent volunteer Athletic Director who oversees the rest of the Sports Board. The Sports Board is made up of commissioners for each sport that the school participates in through the PPSL. In addition, coaches are needed for girls' volleyball, track, and basketball and boys' baseball, basketball, and track and a Christmas Tournament director if the tournament is to return to campus. Information will be sent under separate documents during the particular sport's season.

PAC REIMBURSEMENT POLICY

There is provision for Parent Reimbursements for PAC sponsored events, Class Parties/Events/Auction Parties initiated by the administration, from either the Class Fund, PAC Account, Room Parent Teacher Gift and Lunch Collection or Festival. PAC Events or Class parties are not reimbursed from the Room Parent Teacher Gift Collection.

Class Funds

Created in the kindergarten year, the account follows the class accumulating funds from any class contribution, including specific 8th grade fundraising. In 8th grade these funds are used to cover: the cost of 8th grade trips (outside of CYO) some graduation items, but primarily to cover Mystery Day expenses and graduation. What funds are not used by graduation are restricted by the class to an agreed upon part of St. Charles School i.e., an item that the school may need, or most often a donation to the school Tiger Fund endowment. The class fund is managed by the school bookkeeper and principal.

Parent Activities Account

Each year several PAC Events (BBQ, BWS, and other potential revenue generating events) provide the main source of revenue for this PAC account. Specific budgets are outlined in the Hospitality Event Handbook. Events with budgets for reimbursements include BWS, PAC Coffees, BBQ Catering, January Teacher/Staff Appreciation Lunch, 8th Grade Awards dinner, Speakers, Ambassadors Club)

Room Parent Teacher Gift Collection: Each year, the room parents collect monies to be used for teacher appreciation gifts and the teacher appreciation lunch. These funds are maintained by the room parent in charge of the teacher's gifts. These funds are **not** to be used for class parties, events or the class auction project.

Festival Expenses: Festival expenses are in no way related to school finances and must be approved and reimbursed through the Parish Office.

To Obtain Reimbursement

There is a small 'Request for Check' form in the School Office for individual reimbursements. Attach receipt(s) and description. If the expense is a part of a larger event where multiple people are involved, the event coordinator should be made aware of the expense to include it on the overall PAC-Reimbursement Detail Report which is prepared at the end of an event to report on the aggregate costs/revenues and other event details. The reimbursement form should be returned to the School Office for payment. (Samples attached). The event coordinator should fill in the PAC-Reimbursement Detail Report at the end of an event to include all details pertaining to the event. Forms should go to PAC treasurer for notation before going to the school for payment.

Please note: If a parent donates an otherwise refundable expense or something above and beyond the normal expenses, it should be captured on the Detail Report so that the donor-parent can be acknowledged. Any questions should be addressed to pacchairs@stcharlesschoolsc.org.

Other Class Events: Monthly Teacher Luncheons & Gifts – These funds are managed by one of the Room Parents.

Teacher Luncheons

Each of the 9 grades is assigned a month in which the class hosts a luncheon. This is a way for the class to say 'thank you' to staff/administration and is sponsored by the class. The expectation is that the parents either pay for or prepare a casual lunch. Reimbursement funds are not designated for these luncheons beyond the \$10 PAC Class Collection. 6th Grade is responsible for Annual Catholic Teacher and Staff Appreciation in February and PAC reimburses up to \$400 as this is a more formal luncheon.

Gift Giving

At the discretion of the room parents the trend has been to collect contributions at the beginning of the school year for teachers/support staff and give cash/or gift certificates at Christmas and at the end of the year. These funds are collected by the room-parents and parent participation is entirely optional. There are parents who prefer to do individual gift giving.

Wash, dry, and put away all of the kitchen pots, bowls, coffee pots and any other items used.

Return all chairs and tables to their correct storage areas.

Sweep and mop the entire floor in the hall and kitchen.
