All travel items such as luggage, backpacks, sleeping bags, tents, cots, chairs, etc. must be labeled with trip participant's name and address. Everything you bring should be easily identifiable to a customs officer as your property.

Building site dress code - long pants, sleeved shirts, close-toed shoes, hat, sun screen. In-camp attire - appropriate and comfortable

What not to bring: A bad attitude, alcohol, knives, tobacco, items considered illegal (drugs, firearms, pyrotechnics), skates/skateboards, hockey sticks, lacrosse sticks, curling irons, lighters, cell phones, blow dryers, archery equipment - etc...you get the idea

All prescription and over the counter medications must be in their original containers. All teen's medicines must be turned over to the trip's medical director prior to leaving St. Charles.
